ORDINANCE NO. 1603

AN ORDINANCE ABATING A PORTION OF  
THE TAX LEVY FOR THE VILLAGE OF CHANNAHON  
WILL AND GRUNDY COUNTY, ILLINOIS FOR 2009  
(EQUISTAR ANNEXATION, PIN NUMBERS 03-28-100-003,  
03-28-100-005, & 03-28-100-007, & 03-28-100-011)

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**WHEREAS**, the Village of Channahon adopted Ordinance No. 1100 on April 3, 2000, entitled "An Ordinance Authorizing The Execution of an Annexation Agreement Between The Village of Channahon, And Equistar Chemicals LP, As Owners, For Certain Property Located In The Village of Channahon, Will And Grundy Counties, Illinois"; and

**WHEREAS**, the Village of Channahon is a home rule unit of government;

**WHEREAS**, the Ordinance agreed to abate certain amounts to pay the issuance of said general tax levy; and

**WHEREAS**, the Corporate Authorities of the Village will have on hand sufficient funds to meet the amounts levied.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF CHANNAHON, ILLINOIS, AS FOLLOWS:**

Section 1: That the levy for the tax year 2009 as approved by Ordinance Number 1100, be and the same is hereby abated for the PIN Numbers 03-28-100-003, 03-28-100-005, 03-28-100-007 and 03-28-100-011 only.

Section 2: That the Corporate Authorities do hereby certify to the Clerks of Will and Grundy County that the Village shall have other sources on hand with which the amounts stated and that it will use said sources for such purposes and that the tax levy for the Village of Channahon should be abated to that extent.

Section 3: That a certified copy of this Ordinance shall be filed with the County Clerk.

Section 4: REPEALER. That all ordinances or parts of ordinances conflicting with any provision of this Ordinance shall be and the same are hereby repealed.

Section 5: SEVERABILITY. This Ordinance, and every provision thereof, shall be considered severable and the invalidity of any section, clause, paragraph, sentence or provision of this Ordinance shall not affect the validity of any other portion of this Ordinance.


Section 6: EFFECTIVE DATE. That this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect after its passage, approval and publication in pamphlet form.

PASSED this 07<sup>th</sup> day of December, 2009 with 6 trustees voting aye, 0 trustees voting nay, 0 trustees abstaining, and with 0 trustees absent, the President not voting; said vote being NASH aye, PAPESH aye, MILITELLO aye, GRECO aye, McMILLIN aye, SLOCUM aye and COOK not voting

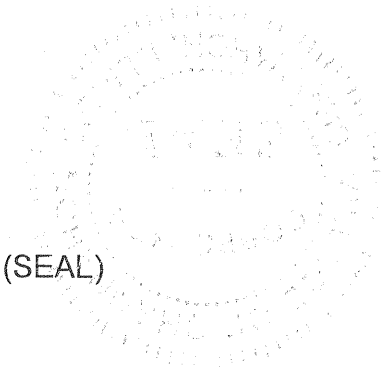
