ORDINANCE NO. 1649

**AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE PLACEMENT  
OF "NO PARKING" SIGNS WITHIN THE  
VILLAGE OF CHANNAHON, WILL AND GRUNDY COUNTIES, ILLINOIS  
(McClintock Road)**

**WHEREAS**, conditions exist in certain areas within the Village of Channahon where the regulation of vehicular parking is in the public interest; and

**WHEREAS**, the public interest can best be protected by the erection of "no parking" signs and enforcement of same at these locations; and

**WHEREAS**, the Board of Trustees has considered and reviewed data with respect to pedestrian activity, the effect of driveways or other entrances, the volume and flow of vehicular traffic and the prevailing speed of free flowing traffic; and

**WHEREAS**, the Board of Trustees is authorized by Illinois Compiled Statutes (Chapter 625, Section 5/11-208(a)(1), to establish "no parking" zones;

**NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF CHANNAHON, WILL AND GRUNDY COUNTIES, STATE OF ILLINOIS AS FOLLOWS:**

**SECTION 1.** That the Director of Public Works of the Village of Channahon is directed to place and maintain the traffic control devices to wit: "no parking" signs, which conform to the Illinois Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices for Streets and Highways for the following locations where parking is prohibited:


1. On the north (westbound) side of McClintock Road from the existing "No Parking" zone created by Ordinance Number 521 to the east lot line of Lot 10 in McDonald Manor Estates Subdivision.

**SECTION 2. SEVERABILITY:** This Ordinance and every provision thereof, shall be considered severable. In the event that any court of competent jurisdiction may find and declare any word, phrase, clause, sentence, paragraph, provision or section or part of a phrase, clause, sentence, paragraph, provision or section of this Ordinance is void or unconstitutional, the remaining words, phrases, clauses, sentences, paragraphs and provisions and parts of phrases, clauses, sentences, paragraphs, provisions and sections not ruled void or unconstitutional shall continue in full force and effect.

**SECTION 3. REPEALER:** All ordinances or parts of Ordinances in conflict with any of the provisions of this ordinance shall be, and the same are hereby repealed.

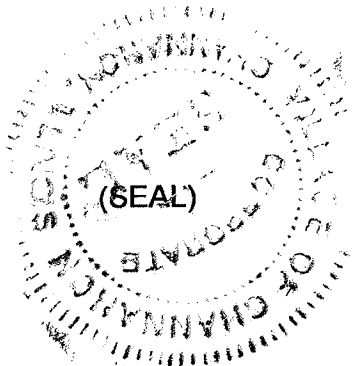
**SECTION 4. EFFECTIVE DATE:** That this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect after its passage, approval and publication in pamphlet form as provided by law.
