ORDINANCE NO. 1666

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE SALE
OF CERTAIN PERSONAL PROPERTY OWNED BY THE
VILLAGE OF CHANNAHON, WILL AND GRUNDY COUNTY, ILLINOIS”

WHEREAS, by a majority vote of the corporate authorities now holding office, the corporate authorities of the Village of Channahon (“Village”) have determined that the personal property described in this Ordinance is no longer necessary or useful to the Village, and;

WHEREAS, the corporate authorities have determined that it is in the best interests to sell said property by public auction; and

WHEREAS , the village is authorized by Section 11-76-4 to sell personal property no longer necessary or useful to the Village.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF CHANNAHON, WILL AND GRUNDY COUNTIES, ILLINOIS, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: That the Village Administrator be and hereby authorized to take all steps reasonable and necessary to effect the sale of the personal property described in Exhibit “A” attached hereto through a public auction to be held Tuesday, September 27, 2011.


Section 2: **REPEALER:** All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances in conflict with any of the provisions of this Ordinance shall be, and the same are hereby repealed.

Section 3 **SEVERABILITY:** This Ordinance and every provision thereof, Shall be considered severable. In the event that any court of competent

jurisdiction may find and declare any word, phrase, clause, sentence, paragraph, provision or section or part of a phrase, clause, sentence, paragraph, provision or section of this Ordinance is void or unconstitutional, the remaining words, phrases, clauses, sentences, paragraphs, provisions or sections not ruled void or unconstitutional shall continue in full force and effect.

Section 4: EFFECTIVE DATE: This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon its passage and approval as provided by law.

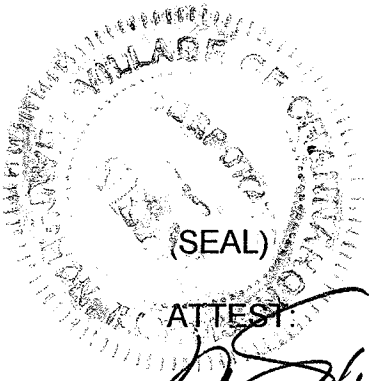
