



Cart Recycling Service

All households are provided with a cart for recycling. Residents can also rent additional recycling carts directly from Waste Management for an annual fee of \$48.00 with a one-time \$15.00 delivery charge. Waste Management will invoice you directly for this service and a one year commitment is required. Recycling will be collected on the same day as refuse, but at different times of the day. The following items may be recycled:



Chipboard and Boxboard



Brown Paper Bags



Phone Books, Books, Catalogs and Magazines



Newspapers



Paper Cardboard, Dairy and Juice Containers



Junk Mail
Including envelopes



Glass Bottles and Jars



Office and School Paper



Cardboard
Collapse boxes. Cut large boxes down to 2'x2'



Plastic Bottles and Containers #1-#5
Return plastic bags to retail store collections



Aluminum Foil and Cans



Tin or Steel Cans
(includes empty non-hazardous aerosol cans)

Follow these simple instructions in preparing your materials for recycling.

- Containers should be empty and rinsed free of excess liquids & food residue.
- Please dispose of all caps before placing in the cart.

Do NOT recycle the following:

- Utensils
- Garden Hoses
- Propane/Helium Tanks
- Mirrors
- Plates
- Lightbulbs
- Hangers/Wire
- Banned Electronics
- Toys
- Fire Extinguishers
- Batteries

Collection Times

All items including yard waste must be placed by the curb no later than 6:00 a.m. the day of collection. Carts should be placed with the handle facing away from the roadway and about two feet apart. After collection, all carts should be removed no later than the evening of your collection day. **Please note: The earliest time for placing items at the curb may be set by Village ordinance or HOA covenants.**

Refuse

The Village utilizes a modified-volume based refuse collection program. Residents can choose from three cart sizes; 35-gallon, 64-gallon, or 96-gallon that best fits their weekly refuse needs.

- Residents must contact Village Hall at 815-467-6644 to establish service.
- Each resident can choose 35-gallon, 64-gallon or 96-gallon carts as the primary refuse container.
- Additional refuse materials may be placed in bags next to the cart.
- A pre-paid sticker must be attached to each additional bag outside of the cart.
- Bulk items such as a chair, couch or furniture will be collected with the weekly pick up. Stickers are not required for these items.
- Carpeting and padding must be cut and rolled into 4-foot lengths. Each roll must not weigh more than 50 pounds and securely tied. Improperly prepared carpeting will not be accepted.

Stickers may also be purchased by calling customer service prepaid by credit card or check over the phone.

Yard Waste

Yard waste such as grass clippings, leaves, tree branches and brush is collected weekly on your scheduled pickup day from April 1st through the week in which November 30th occurs. The Village also utilizes a modified-volume based program for yard waste materials.

- All Yard waste must be placed in kraft paper bags which can be purchased at local retail stores.
- A pre-paid sticker must be attached to each bag of yard waste prior to collection.
- Brush and branches must be cut into 4-foot lengths, bundled with string or twine. Brush and branch bundles **do not** require a sticker.
- Each bundle must not exceed 50 pounds.
- Whole trees, tree stumps and/or improperly prepared bundles will not be accepted.
- Leaves will be collected from Oct 1 through November 30 at no charge.
- Leaves must be placed in kraft bags.
- Two additional leaf collections will take place in the fall. Please check with the Village for the dates and set out requirements.

Yard waste subscription services are available for residents with greater yard waste needs. Residents can call Waste Management to rent a 96-gallon yard waste cart for an annual fee of \$155.00 in lieu of purchasing kraft bags and stickers.

Residents utilizing this service can place all of their yard waste in the provided 96-gallon cart and include up to 5 additional kraft bags without stickers. Stickers are required for any additional bags over the 5-bag limit. This service will also be billed directly to residents from Waste Management and is billed annually with a required one-year commitment.

Electronic Waste Ban

Effective January 1, 2012, the State of Illinois has banned electronics from landfill disposal including the following items:

- Televisions
- Monitors
- Printers
- Computers (laptop, notebook, netbook, tablet, desktop)
- Electronic Keyboards
- Facsimile (Fax) Machines
- Videocassette Recorders (VCRs)
- Portable Digital Music Players (MP3 Players, iPods, etc.)
- Digital Video Disc (DVD) Players
- Video Game Consoles
- Small Scale Servers
- Scanners
- Electronic Mice
- Digital Converter Boxes
- Cable Receivers
- Satellite Receivers
- Digital Video Disc Recorders

Residents with these electronic wastes can call Vintage Tech Recyclers at (866) 631-1707 for free home collection. Residents may also bring electronic wastes to Channahon Township - S Fryer Street, seven blocks South of Rt. 6 (turn at Subway) 815-467-2299 Hours: Wed 3pm-7pm **March-Oct. ONLY** Sat 8am-2pm year-round.

Restricted Items

The following items will not be collected:

- Construction/demolition materials
- Automotive parts
- Hazardous wastes (oil-based paint, oil, flammables, hot ash, etc.)
- Dirt, Stone, Concrete, Rock
- Medical Wastes/Needles
- Swimming Pools
- Tires
- Pesticides/Insecticides
- Antifreeze
- Banned Electronics
