**SANITARY SEWER IMPROVEMENTS ON MCCLINTOCK ROAD
TO BEGIN ON WEDNESDAY, SEPTEMBER 16, 2015**

Sanitary sewer improvements on McClintock Road, between the Lower Rock Run Dog Park and the Channahon Community Park, will begin Wednesday, September 16, 2015. This work is part of the City of Joliet's U.S. Route 6 Sanitary Sewer Improvements project.

Construction activities will require temporary lane closures and detours on McClintock Road between the hours of 7:00 AM and 5:30 PM. Detour signs will be posted. The detoured sections of McClintock Road will be reopened to traffic at the end of each day. Construction duration is anticipated to be 4 to 6 weeks.
