PURPOSE

The purpose of the Grundy County Law Enforcement Managers Association Scholarship Fund is to provide financial assistance toward an Associate, Baccalaureate, or Master's degree, preferably in a Criminal Justice or Law Enforcement related field. Four (4) scholarships of \$500 will be awarded for the 2019-2020 school year.

QUALIFICATIONS FOR APPLICATION

There shall be no restriction on any applicant by reason of race, age, creed, color, sex, or national origin. The only limitation are the following:

- Applicants must be enrolled as full-time students for the fall semester of the 2019-2020 school year.*
- Preference will be given to Grundy County residents, family members of active or retired Grundy County Law Enforcement Officials, family members of current or retired Association members, individuals seeking a degree in a criminal justice related field, and individuals who have not received the Association's scholarship in the past.*
- Applicants should demonstrate a proven work ethic, an interest in their community, and public service.*
