ORDINANCE NO. 2059

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE VILLAGE OF CHANNAHON  
CODE OF ORDINANCES WITH RESPECT TO WATER

---

**WHEREAS**, Section 52.067 of the Village of Channahon (the “Village”) Code of Ordinances restricts water use for lawn irrigation and other activities as the Village President may proclaim; and

**WHEREAS**, the Village recognizes that a healthy, safe, and reliable water supply is fundamental to the quality of life of its residents; and

**WHEREAS**, the Village supports the necessity and benefit of water conservation; and

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND VILLAGE BOARD OF THE VILLAGE OF CHANNAHON, WILL AND GRUNDY COUNTIES, ILLINOIS, IN THE EXERCISE OF ITS HOME RULE AND OTHER POWERS, AS FOLLOWS:**

**SECTION 1:**

That Paragraph (A) of Section of 52.067 of the Village Code of Ordinances is hereby deleted and replaced with the following amended Paragraph (A) of Section 52.067:

(A) Water from the Village’s public water supply may only be used for watering or sprinkling of lawns as follows:

1. All properties with even-numbered street numbers may use public water supply for lawn watering purposes on even-numbered calendar days between the hours of 6:00 a.m. to 9:00 a.m. and 6:00 p.m. to 9:00 p.m. and is prohibited at all other times.
2. All properties with odd-numbered street numbers may use public water supply for lawn watering purposes on odd-numbered calendar days between the hours of 6:00 a.m. to 9:00 a.m. and 6:00 p.m. to 9:00 p.m. and is prohibited at all other times.
3. The filling of swimming pools is not restricted by time of day, but must comply with the odd and even numbered day restrictions in 1 and 2 above.

## **SECTION 2:**

That the last sentence of Paragraph (B) of Section 52.067 be changed to read "...posted at the Village of Channahon Municipal Building."

## **SECTION 3:**

That the following Paragraph (C) be added to Section 52.067 after Paragraph (B):

(C) The lawn watering restrictions set forth in Paragraph (A) above shall not apply in the following circumstances:

1. Newly installed sod and seed may be watered during the first ten (10) days after installation. Water from the Village water distribution system may be used for watering of the newly installed sod or seed for up to eight (8) hours per day. After the first 10 days the odd/even day and hourly time restrictions in Paragraph (A) above will apply.
2. The watering of gardens, trees, shrubs and flowers, by use of a handheld hose or watering can, is not restricted.

## **SECTION 4:**

That Sections 52.125 and 52.126 shall be deleted in their entirety.

## **SECTION 5:**

That Paragraph (B) of Section 52.999 be changed to read "In addition to the penalty provided in (A) above, any violation of the water use restrictions of Section 52.067 shall be grounds for termination of water service."

## **SECTION 6: SEVERABILITY**

This ordinance and every provision thereof shall be considered severable. In the event that any court of competent jurisdiction may find and declare any word, phrase, clause, sentence, paragraph, provision or section or part of a phrase, clause, sentence, paragraph, provision or section of this Ordinance is void or unconstitutional, the remaining words, phrases, clauses, sentences, paragraphs provisions and sections and parts of phrases, clauses, sentences, paragraphs, provisions and sections not ruled void or unconstitutional shall continue in full force and effect.

## **SECTION 7: REPEALER**

All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances in conflict with any of the provisions of this Ordinance shall be, and the same are hereby repealed.

**SECTION 8: EFFECTIVE DATE**

That this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect after its passage, approval and publication in pamphlet form as provided by law.
